

**County of Vermilion River
Bylaw No. 12-20**

A Bylaw of the County of Vermilion River in the Province of Alberta, to authorize volunteer firefighters to use flashing green lights in their vehicles.

WHEREAS, Section 28.2 of the Traffic Safety Act, being Alberta Regulation 122/2009 with amendments up to and including Alberta Regulation 31/2012 and amendments thereto, gives municipalities the power to pass a bylaw allowing full time and volunteer firefighters to use flashing green lights in their vehicles as a means of identification;

THEREFORE, the Council of the County of Vermilion River, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:


1. A full time or volunteer firefighter may carry on or in a vehicle, other than an emergency vehicle, a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp in the County of Vermilion River if the vehicle is proceeding to a fire or other emergency.
2. No person other than a full time or volunteer firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
3. Nothing in this Bylaw shall be construed so as to permit a full time or volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of the Traffic Safety Act, any other provincial legislation or regulation, or any Bylaw of the County of Vermilion River.
4. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
