

**COUNTY OF VERMILION RIVER NO. 24
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BYLAW 03-17**

A BYLAW of the County of Vermilion River No. 24 ("the County") in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing to public travel and disposing of the portion of a public highway in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, revised statutes of Alberta 1994, as amended.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the highway closed, and

WHEREAS the Council of the County of Vermilion River No. 24 deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter disposing of same, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the County of Vermilion River No. 24 in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and dispose of the following described highway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

All that portion of Service Road, Registered Plan 952-0895, contained within Lot 6, Block 1, Registered Plan 032-_____ Containing 0.280 hectares (0.69 acres) more or less. Excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
