



**COUNTY OF VERMILION RIVER  
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA  
BY-LAW NO. 07-19**

- A BY-LAW** of the County of Vermilion River ("the County") in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing to public travel and disposing of portions of a public roadway in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, revised statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended.
- WHEREAS** the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and
- WHEREAS** application has been made to Council to have the roadway closed, and
- WHEREAS** the Council of the County of Vermilion River deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter disposing of same, and
- WHEREAS** notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and
- WHEREAS** Council has not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the County of Vermilion River in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel and dispose of the following described roadway, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:  
ALL THAT PORTION OF 51 AVENUE (FORMERLY KNOWN AS FIRST AVENUE) EAST OF 54 STREET (FORMERLY FIRST STREET) AS SHOWN ON ROAD PLAN 7492BE AFFECTING THE FOLLOWING QUARTER SECTION : NW 01-50-02-W4.



