

**COUNTY OF VERMILION RIVER  
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA  
BYLAW NO. 08-23**

**A BYLAW** of the County of Vermilion River, in the Province of Alberta, to designate the Site and Building known as the Holy Trinity Anglican Church of Irwinville as a Municipal Historic Resource.

**WHEREAS** Sections 26 of the Historical Resources Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, c.H-9, and amendments permits Council to designate any historic resource within the County of Vermilion River whose preservation Council considers to be in the public interest, together with any land in or on which it is located; as a Municipal Historic Resource; and

**WHEREAS** the preservation of the Holy Trinity Anglican Church of Irwinville in the County of Vermilion River is deemed to be in the public interest; and

**WHEREAS** The Synod of the Diocese of Edmonton who are the owners of the Holy Trinity Anglican Church of Irwinville have agreed to waive compensation now and in the future

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the County of Vermilion River, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

The Holy Trinity Anglican Church of Irwinville located on land legally described as:

Title 48V81  
West of Meridian 4,  
Range 3  
Township 52  
Section SW19  
Area: (.04 acres) more or less

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

In the County of Vermilion River is hereby designated as a Municipal Historic Resource.

Should any provision of the Bylaw be determined to be invalid, then such provisions shall be severed and the remaining Bylaw shall be maintained.

This Bylaw comes into effect upon its final passing thereof.
