**THE COUNTY OF VERMILION RIVER
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BYLAW 11-28**

A Bylaw of the County of Vermilion River in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing to public travel and creating title to portions of a public highway in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26.1, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the County of Vermilion River deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and therefore disposing of same, and

WHEREAS the notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act,

AND WHEREAS Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the County of Vermilion River in the Province of Alberta does hereby close to public travel for the purpose of creating title to the following, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation:

THAT PORTION OF ROAD AND LANE AS SHOWN ON PLAN 4618EO THAT IS ADJACENT TO BLOCK 1, LOT 5 AND THAT PORTION OF LANE AS SHOWN ON PLAN 4618EO THAT IS ADJACENT TO BLOCK 1, LOTS 2 THROUGH 5 IN THE SE 18-53-5 W4M CONTAINED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF PLAN

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

As shown on Schedule A attached hereto.

SHOULD any provision of this Bylaw be determined to be invalid, then such provisions shall be severed and the remaining bylaw shall be maintained.

THIS Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon receiving third and final reading and having been signed by the Reeve and Chief Administrative Officer.
