

COUNTY OF VERMILION RIVER NO. 24
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
BY-LAW NO. 99-6

A BY-LAW of the County of Vermilion River No. 24 in the Province of Alberta concerning the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy.

AND WHEREAS Pursuant to Section 89 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, S.A. 1994, c. F-18.5, the County of Vermilion River No. 24 must designate a person or group of persons as the head of the County of Vermilion River No. 24 for the purposes of the Act;

PURPOSE: the purpose of this Bylaw is to establish the administrative structure of the County of Vermilion River No. 24 in relation to the the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, and to set fees thereunder.

DEFINITIONS: In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

- a) the **"Act"** means the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, S.A. 1994, c.F-18.5;
- b) **"Applicant"** means a person who makes a request for access to a record under section 7 (1) of the Act;
- c) **"County"** means the County of Vermilion River No. 24 and includes any board, committee, commission, panel, agency or corporation that is created or owned by the County of Vermilion River No. 24 and all the members or officers of which are appointed or chosen by the County of Vermilion River No. 24;
- d) **"County Administrator"** means the person appointed as the Chief Administrative Officer of the County of Vermilion River No. 24, and includes any person who holds the position of County Administrator in an Acting capacity;
- e) **"Province"** means the Province of Alberta.

DESIGNATED HEAD For the purpose of the Act, the County Administrator is designated as the Head of the County of Vermilion River No. 24.

FEES Where an Applicant is required to pay a fee for services, the fee payable is in accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation*, AR 200/95, as amended from time to time or any successor Regulation that sets fees for requests for information from the Province.

EFFECTIVE DATE This Bylaw comes into effect on October 1, 1999
