DOG LICENSING

Dog Licenses are required for any dog over the age of 3 months within **HAMLETS** and **RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISIONS**. Licenses are valid for the lifetime of the dog. A dog license with up-to-date contact information ensures our Dog Control Officer can contact you if your dog is found.



\$50/Licence and **\$5**/Replacement License



NUMBER OF DOGS

No more than **2** dogs per residence in **HAMLETS** and **RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISIONS**

No more than **4** dogs per residence in rural areas

RESPONSIBILITY OF OWNERS

Offences under Part 4 of the bylaw will only be enforced within **HAMLETS** and **RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISIONS**.



DANGEROUS DOGS

Offences under Part 5 are enforced throughout the County. If an offence occurs, the details are reviewed and the dog may be declared dangerous. Owners of a dangerous dog have to follow specific requirements. Dangerous Dog offenses are double regular dog control offenses.

ENFORCEMENT

At Large dogs can be picked up by our Dog Control Officer or County Peace Officers. Any dogs picked up will be brought to the Lloydminster SPCA. When picking up your dog, any impound/animal shelter fees will need to be paid before your dog will be released. Owners may also be charged a fine under this bylaw.

COMMON OFFENSES

- Unlicensed Dogs
- Dog not wearing a License Tag when off Owner's Property
- Person keeps more than the permitted number of Dogs
- Dog is At Large
- Excessive Barking



DANGEROUS DOG OFFENSES

- Dog threatens, attacks, bites, injures, or otherwise harasses any Person or any other Animal
- Dog which chases a motor vehicle, person on horseback or a person that is walking or running.

PENALTIES

Municipal Tag
First Offence **\$100**
Second Offence **\$200**
Third or subsequent Offence **\$400**

Double the specified penalty for Dangerous Dog offenses and for dogs declared dangerous by the County
