Policy Statement:

The County of Vermilion River will have a flag as part of their public awareness and identification efforts.

Background:

1. The County has historically had a flag – the previous colors were blue and white on a red background
2. The County name was shortened to “County of Vermilion River” as of the Ministerial Order on September 13, 2006 and a new Logo, County Sign and Flag design was done that reflects this new name
3. The new logo and name was used on the flag – the three color reflecting the main attributes of the County – blue represents the three rivers that are part of our boundaries or meander through the centre of the County / green represents the agricultural heritage of the area / black represents the prevalent heavy oil and gas resources and activity in our region

Guidelines

1. Council will approve the design of the County flag.
2. The County will provide, free of cost, one new flag each year to each school and fire hall within the County boundaries, if they request one
3. The County will provide, free of cost, one new flag each year to the County parks

Implementation

1. Schools within our boundaries will be advised of this policy
2. A provision for costs for the supply of flags will be included in the Administration budget
