**Purpose:**

The County of Vermilion River wishes to acknowledge students who attend Vermilion Lakeland College, who excel at post-secondary programs that support the Agriculture Industry, which is the foundation industry of our province.

**Background:**

The County of Vermilion River provides awards in order to provide recognition to students who excel by achieving the highest mark in English 30-1 and English 30-2.

In September 2004, as per motion #81-09-04, Council established an award in the amount of \$300.00 per award/per student for Agriculture Conservation & Vegetation Diploma Program. In June 2006 this program was renamed Conservation and Restoration Ecology

**Guidelines:**

1. This award of \$300.00 is available on an annual basis.
2. The Conservation and Restoration Ecology Award is to be provided to a second year student:
  - a. who is enrolled at the Vermilion Lakeland College, and
  - b. has a full course load, and
  - c. achieves the highest academic standing with the final selection for the award to be done by the Awards Committee, that is established by Lakeland College.

**Procedure:**

1. Schools are to provide the name of the student, who has been selected for the Award, to the County office, a minimum of three weeks prior to the date the awards are to be presented, to facilitate the production of a cheque.
2. Council will be advised of the date of the Awards Event, to allow for representation and presentation of the Awards.
