Policy Statement:

The County of Vermilion River wishes to use a consistent and prescribed approach to recognize County residents, who reach specific milestone events in their lives.

Background:

Current staff and council are recognized for Long Service by the AAMD&C and the County Policy PE 024.

The Alberta Government has a program with similar benchmarks.

Definitions:

County resident is one who resides in the County – including long time County residents now in an urban centre but not other residents of the villages and town within its boundaries

Guidelines:

1. Upon request by the family or council becoming aware of a County Resident, who is celebrating their 25 plus Wedding Anniversary and/or their 65 plus Birthday will be recognized by means of a framed congratulatory scroll (County Certificate of Recognition) that is signed by the Councillor for the Division and the Reeve.
2. It is recognized that a councillor may wish to provide a personal token to these individuals at their own expense.
3. The Reeve or Councillor for the Division will provide direction on how / when the certificate or token of recognition will be delivered.

Implementation:

1. Budgets shall provide for adequate resources to implement the standards set out in this policy
