Council Corner

The rains have been welcomed by everyone, except maybe our grader operators as rain always brings the challenges of keeping up with road issues. It has been nice to watch our countryside turn green, however.

It has been a very busy spring for everyone and we are happy to have the dust suppression program and weed programs underway. Council has also been getting more information on other solutions to the Blackfoot wastewater issue. Council has met several times in the past few months to discuss this project with engineering. Also high on the priority list for Council has been the County of Vermilion River Land Use Bylaw. At our June 20, 2024 Policy and Priorities Committee meeting Council met with staff and Municipal Planning Services and will be scheduling an open house with the draft Land Use Bylaw for the public to take a look at in the fall of 2024. We hope that many of our residents will take the opportunity to attend.

At the May 14, 2024 Regular Meeting of Council ATCO EnPower presented information on the Kitscoty wind farm. A public information session/open house is being planned by ATCO for the fall of 2024. Personal consultations with landowners within 800 metres of the project footprint are planned to start in the summer of 2024.

By the end of summer staff will be moving out of the current Kitscoty Administration building to make way for office renovations. Details regarding the temporary office location will be provided in a press release very soon.
