<u>VERMILION RIVER REGIONAL WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES COMMISSION</u> INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

Council accepted the report as information and directed Administration to update the Indemnity Agreement and seek an agreement to encompass the services that the County of Vermilion River provides to the Commission.

VERSORIUM ENERGY TAX INCENTIVE

Council approved a tax refund for 2025 and 2026 to Versorium Energy for 50 per cent of the municipal taxes for a two-year period for the development on SE-1-51-4W4M now that the developed facility has reached commercial operation as follows:

- Assessment year 2024 (municipal taxation year 2025) 50 per cent of Municipal Taxes for 2025.
- Assessment year 2024 (municipal taxation year 2026) 50 per cent of Municipal Taxes for 2026.

Council passed two Readings of Bylaw 25-04 a bylaw to amend Bylaw 19-01 Councillor Code of Conduct as amended with changes to Section 6 and 7.1. The Third Reading of this Bylaw will be brought forward at the March 25, 2025 Regular Meeting of Council.
